## OFFICERS REPORTS

Vice President: We would like to thank everyone who helped with the Book Fair, including the Committee and volunteers. The Family Fun Night was a well attended event. A reminder was made to all co-chairs of events that the PTG does not need to be cc'd on every email communication when planning an event, just the major emails or summaries of the event that is coming up.

Treasurer: For the Book Fair, we chose to do a half cash option, and made \$2025, and earned $\$ 2300$ in Scholastic Dollars. Box Tops sent us a check for $\$ 269$. The Candy Gram fundraiser brought in $\$ 919$. For the Staff Appreciation event coming soon, the budget is approximately $\$ 1800$.

Secretary: Reminder to all Chairs and Co-Chairs that anything to be handed out needs to come to us first for approval. This includes flyers, invitations, and other items of similar nature. There were some minor issues at the beginning of the year with things going out without approval and having incorrect information on them.

## COMMITTEES \& EVENTS:

Playground Improvement: The preliminary planning from 2018 was discussed, and any projects taken on will occur during the summer, so as to not disrupt the daily use of the area during the school year.

Spring Pastries with Parents: We have a full committee now, and they will be planning an event outside in May. The committee will be meeting to start planning this event.
